"About three weeks after Tina was born, it seemed like she wasn't developing as she should've been. We anxiously searched to find out what was going on with our little girl. The answer was that part of a chromosome was dislodged and attached to another chromosome.

When Tina was about a year old, an organization that helps people with intellectual and developmental disabilities opened a special preschool that she was able to attend. As our daughter grew, however, so did her special needs. Over the years, we provided all of our love and support, knowing that one day, she would require additional care.

As Tina got older and required more extensive services, a family who lived nearby told us about Peppermint Ridge. The minute we walked onto the campus, we knew it was the right place for our daughter. And after we spoke to the staff and received more information, a friendly Ridge resident walked up and said, 'Hi Tina, let me show you my room!'

We went through a trial period thinking it would be a big adjustment. We asked, 'Tina, would you like to live at Peppermint Ridge?' We were so surprised when she answered, 'Yeah, okay!' It was really <u>her</u> choice, and after 30 years it's still her home. She likes to come to our home regularly, but after staying for a few days, she will tell us that she is ready to return to her friends at the Ridge.

Tina has always been a sweet, sociable, and happy person. She enjoys doing 300-piece puzzles, Ridge social activities, and hanging out with her friends and housemates. Sometimes we say, 'Life can be hard, but not for Tina.' She's always smiling, even on a challenging day!
